

Your property is currently eligible for UK government funding to improve your broadband under the Gigabit Broadband Voucher Scheme.

This means you can **claim a voucher worth £4,500*** which would contribute towards building an Ultrafast Full Fibre broadband network for you and your community.

If you and your neighbours pledge and validate your UK Gigabit Vouchers we can get started on the build through our **Fibre Community Partnership** programme.

My broadband speed is ok, why should I do this?

Fibre optic cables use light instead of electric signals – they're tough, weather-resistant, and data travels through them at almost lightspeed.

You may already have access to fibre through a superfast or FTTC broadband connection which is a mix of fibre and copper technology.

Ultrafast full fibre is different. It is a direct fibre connection from our exchange straight into your home or business and is up to 10x faster than the average connection**.

You'll need an engineer visit and a new router, but it's ultra-easy to set up our fastest and most reliable broadband yet. Ultrafast is broadband that's ready for anything.

Are there any terms and conditions I should be aware of?

Yes. By pledging and validating your voucher you are saying you'll order a full fibre service once it's available to you.

Can I use the voucher to meet my current broadband costs?

No. The voucher can only be put towards the cost of the network build. You'll have to pay for a broadband package.

How much will it cost?


Prices vary per provider. You could also ask your existing provider about an upgrade.

How long will it take?

Our network build usually takes around 12 months, but it can take longer in some cases. Please note, vouchers from the Gigabit Broadband Voucher Scheme expire after 12 months.
