
By location, we completed the following missions:

- 1 Yorkshire


November Mission Breakdown


Last month, we responded to 115 missions.

We provided life-saving emergency anaesthetics to 13 patients, and for three patients, we administered a total of 13 units of blood products.










Additionally, our critical care cars played a crucial role, responding to 54 incidents. Overall, we transported 38 patients to six different hospitals, ensuring they received the specialised care they needed.

The most prevalent emergency type we responded to were medical emergencies with 49 call-outs.







When a woman suffered a cardiac arrest at her home in Nottingham, our crew were by her side in 20 minutes. Working alongside our colleagues in East Midlands Ambulance Service, our doctor and paramedic performed pre-hospital emergency anaesthesia before escorting the patient to Nottingham's Queen's Medical Centre by road ambulance.
